## HEATED CUTTING BOARD USAGE AND CARE



### Usage & Cleaning

Your heated induction cutting board contains proprietary materials that allow the operator to use the heated cutting board similar to a standard cutting board, however the technology is **only** compatible with Lion's Wood induction holding/warming products.

1. When using your Lion's Wood heated cutting board, you should **never exceed 200 watts** of power. It is also extremely important that you are utilizing a Lion's Wood induction holding/warming product, as induction cooking units draw too much power and will permanently damage your cutting board.
2. Always place or slide the Heated Cutting Board gently on the LINK Box surface. Do not drop, slam or toss the Heated Cutting Board onto the LINK Box, as it could damage the product. Position the Heated Cutting Board flush with the LINK Box in order for the technology to properly activate.
3. Do not submerge the heated cutting board in water for cleaning but rather wipe the cutting board down with warm, soapy water. Prolonged submersion may permanently damage the heated cutting board.
4. Your induction cutting board is **NOT** dishwasher safe. Placing the Lion's Wood heated cutting board in the dishwasher may warp or render the technology unusable.
